

SMILE OUT LOUD FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

- Amount:** \$700
- Eligibility:** Graduating seniors of a public or private high school in Lancaster County, Nebraska.
- Criteria:** 2- or 4-year college in Nebraska,

The David Staenberg established the Smile Out Loud Foundation Scholarship in 2015 to support post-secondary education for students with dyslexia. David is dyslexic himself and his Smile Out Loud Foundation works to raise awareness of dyslexia. He believes in changing the world one Smile at a time.

CRITERIA

1. Applicant must be a current graduating senior of a **public or private high school in Lancaster County in Nebraska.**
2. Applicant must plan to attend any accredited two-year or four-year university or college.
3. Applicant must demonstrate a confirmed condition of dyslexia.

APPLICATION

Eligible applicants may apply either online at <http://www.lcf.org/impacting-community/student-scholarships> or request a fillable .pdf form at robertm@lcf.org . The requested form can be completed either by printing and mailing by regular mail or by typing in the .pdf fields and returning it attached in an e-mail to robertm@lcf.org. Mailed applications must be post-marked no later than March 15th. Electronic applications must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. on March 15th.

Application required attachments:

1. High school **transcript(s)** (copies of transcripts are acceptable).
2. One letter of recommendation from a school teacher, counselor or administrator, or a physician that confirms the applicant's dyslexia condition.
3. **Essay:** *Describe how dyslexia has affected your studies and how it influences your future educational, occupational, and personal goals.* Your essay should be no more than 500 words and be typed on no more than 1 attached page.

AWARD

The Lincoln Community Foundation will make the final selection of scholarship recipients.
