

## Structured Literacy Workshop (Based on Orton-Gillingham Multi-Sensory Methodology)

This Structured Literacy 5-day training, is designed for teachers, tutors, and parents wanting to learn to help dyslexic students and all students who struggle with reading, writing, and spelling. This methodology is appropriate for individual, small and whole group instruction.



**What is structured literacy? 20% of the population is dyslexic? Dyslexia law?**  
Do you have questions? Then this is the class for you. We will review the Nebraska State Department of Education's "Dyslexia Guide" to build an understanding of dyslexia, to dispel myths, to learn about current Nebraska reading laws and what this means for teachers and students. You will learn to assess and teach using Structured Literacy techniques based on the proven Orton-Gillingham multisensory instructional methods. The course demonstrates how to build phonological awareness, phonetic decoding and encoding skills, fluency, vocabulary and comprehension in reading.

**Instructor:** Sandra Stark, M.ED. holds a Master's Degree from Doane University plus an additional 8 graduate hours in structured literacy / multisensory education, and 36 years of elementary teaching experience. As a Title 1 teacher, she incorporated the Structured Literacy approach (based on Orton-Gillingham multi-sensory methodology) into the teaching of reading. She has taught and holds certificates to teach five structured literacy programs: Project Read, A-Z Phonics, Orton-Gillingham, VoWac and Comprehensive Reading Instruction. Sandy is on the Board of the Nebraska Dyslexia Association.
